## IN THE TWENTIETH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT IN AND FOR THE STATE OF FLORIDA

IN RE: COSTS IN CIRCUIT COURT ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 3.1

Pursuant to the authorities cited below and the inherent authority of the court as provided in Fla. R. Jud. Admin. 2.215 and Florida Statute §43.26, the following schedule of fees is applicable in the Circuit Court.

## A. Mandatory Court Costs

1. The Circuit Court <u>shall</u> impose the following costs in <u>all</u> felony cases where the defendant pleads guilty or nolo contendere or is otherwise convicted of a felony:

\$225	Local Government Criminal Justice Trust Fund Florida Statute 938.05(1)(a)
\$ 65	County Court Costs Florida Statute 939.185(1)(a), when assessed by a county ordinance
\$ 50	Crimes Compensation Trust Fund Florida Statute 938.03(1)
\$ 50	Crime Prevention Fund (only if a fine is ordered) Florida Statute 775.083(2)  Additional Court Cost Clearing Trust Fund
\$ 3	Additional Court Cost Clearing Trust Fund Florida Statute 938.01(1)
\$ 2	Local Law Enforcement Education and Training Florida Statute 938.15, when assessed by a county or municipality

- 2. The Circuit Court <u>shall</u> impose the following surcharges on <u>each</u> felony <u>fine</u> that is assessed against a defendant:
  - \$ 20 Crime Stoppers Trust Fund Florida Statute 938.06(1)
  - 5% surcharge on fine for Crimes Compensation Trust Fund Florida Statute 938.04
- 3. The Circuit Court <u>shall</u> impose the following cost in <u>all</u> felony traffic violation <u>cases</u> (violations of F.S. 316) where the defendant pleads guilty or nolo contendere or is otherwise convicted of a felony traffic offense:

- \$ 15 Court Facilities
  Florida Statute 318.18(13)(a)
- \$ 3 State Radio System Surcharge Florida Statute 318.18(17)
- 4. The Circuit Court <u>shall</u> impose the following additional court costs for <u>each</u> felony <u>violation</u> of Florida Statute 316.192 (Reckless Driving) where the defendant pleads guilty or nolo contendere or is otherwise convicted:
  - \$ 5 E.M.S. Trust Fund Florida Statute 316.192(4)
- 5. The Circuit Court <u>shall</u> impose the following additional court costs for <u>each</u> felony <u>violation</u> of Florida Statute 316.193 (DUI) where the defendant pleads guilty or nolo contendere or is otherwise convicted:
  - \$135 E.M.S. Trust Fund
    Operating Trust Fund of the Dept. of Law Enforcement
    Brain & Spinal Cord Injury Rehab. Trust Fund
    Florida Statute 938.07
- 6. The Circuit Court <u>shall</u> impose the following additional court costs for <u>each</u> felony <u>violation</u> of Florida Statute 327.35 (BUI) where the defendant pleads guilty or nolo contendere or is otherwise convicted:
  - \$135 E.M.S. Trust Fund
    Operating Trust Fund of the Dept. of Law Enforcement
    Brain & Spinal Cord Injury Rehab. Trust Fund
    Florida Statute 938.07
  - \$ 60 Brain & Spinal Cord Injury Rehab. Trust Fund Florida Statute 327.35(9)
- 7. The Circuit Court shall impose the following additional court costs for each felony violation of Florida Statutes 784.011, 784.021, 784.03, 784.041, 784.045, 784.048, 784.07, 784.08, 784.081, 784.082, 784.083, 784.085, 794.011, or for any offense of domestic violence described in Fla. Stat. 741.28 where the defendant pleads guilty or nolo contendere or is otherwise convicted:
  - \$201 Domestic Violence Surcharge Domestic Violence Trust Fund Florida Statute 938.08
  - \$151 Rape Crisis Center Florida Statute 938.085

8. The Circuit Court <u>shall</u> impose the following additional court costs for <u>each</u> felony <u>offense</u> against a minor in violation of Florida Statutes 784.085, chapter 787, chapter 794, 796.03, 800.04, chapter 827, 847.0145, or 985.4045 where the defendant pleads guilty or nolo contendere or is otherwise convicted:

\$101 Child Advocacy Trust Fund Florida Statute 938.10(1)

9. The Circuit Court <u>shall</u> impose the costs of prosecution, including investigative costs:

\$100 unless Cost of Prosecution & Investigation higher amount Florida Statute 938.27 ordered by court

10. The Circuit Court <u>shall</u> assess attorney's fees and costs to any defendant convicted who has received the assistance of the public defender, regional counsel, or a conflict attorney:

\$100 unless Public Defender Fees higher amount Florida Statute 938.29 ordered by court

## B. Discretionary Court Costs

1. The Circuit Court <u>may</u> impose the following additional court costs for <u>each</u> felony <u>violation</u> of Florida Statutes chapter 893, 316.193, 856.011, 856.015, chapter 562, chapter 567, or chapter 568, where the defendant pleads guilty or nolo contendere or is otherwise convicted:

Up to fine Alcohol Drug Abuse Program amount Florida Statute 938.21

2. The Circuit Court <u>may</u> impose the following additional court costs for <u>each</u> felony <u>violation</u> of Florida Statutes 893.13, where the defendant pleads guilty or nolo contendere or is otherwise convicted:

\$100 Statewide Crime Lab Florida Statute 938.25

3. The Circuit Court <u>may</u> impose the following fine for <u>each</u> felony <u>violation</u> of Florida Statutes where the defendant pleads guilty or nolo contendere or is otherwise convicted:

Up to	Fines (3 <sup>rd</sup> Degree Felony)
\$5,000	Florida Statute 775.083
Up to	Fines (1 <sup>st</sup> or 2 <sup>nd</sup> Degree Felony)
\$10,000	Florida Statute 775.083
Up to \$15,000	Fines (Life Felony) Florida Statute 775.083

All fines, costs, penalties or other assessments against any defendant in accordance with this administrative order shall be collected by the Clerk of the Court and distributed in accordance with the applicable provisions of Florida law and the Distribution Schedule of Court-Related Filing Fees, Service Charges, Costs, and Fines published by the Florida Association of Court Clerks, Inc.

The monetary fines and costs imposed by the court shall be deemed to include only statutory and constitutional costs and fees. Any cost found to be unconstitutional by any court of superior jurisdiction shall be considered as part of the fine imposed and shall be distributed as otherwise provided by law.

To the extent that any provision of this Administrative Order may conflict with any rule, statute or law, the rule, statute or law shall prevail. More specifically, to the extent that the Legislature may make subsequent amendments that increase, decrease, add or delete any cost, fines or fees, those legislative amendments shall prevail.
