WHEREAS, Fla. Stat. §948.09 provides that any person ordered by the court to be placed on probation, drug offender probation, or community control must, as a condition of any placement, pay to the Florida Department of Corrections a total sum of money equal to the total month or portion of a month of supervision times the court-ordered amount, but not to exceed the actual per diem cost of supervision, and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to have a uniform rate within the Twentieth Judicial Circuit for equity and enforcement purposes, it is hereby

ORDERED that all offenders within the Twentieth Judicial Circuit placed on probation, drug offender probation, or community control, and under the supervision of the Florida

Department of Corrections, shall pay costs of supervision in the amount of \$50.00 per month, unless otherwise ordered by the sentencing court. All felony offenders shall also pay a \$2.00 per month surcharge pursuant to Fla. Stat. §948.09(1)(a)2. (2003). This order shall not be construed as limiting the Department's authority to charge any additional surcharges as authorized by statute or rule, and shall not be construed as limiting the Department's authority to exempt any person from payment as authorized by statute or rule.
