TEMPORARY ORDER WAIVING TIME REQUIREMENT FOR
SUMMONING JURORS FOR COURT PROCEEDINGS
IN GLADES COUNTY


Due to circumstances beyond the control of the Glades County Clerk of the Court (specifically an equipment failure), it appears that the selection of jurors by computer in Glades County pursuant to Local Rule VII of the Twentieth Judicial Circuit Court may or will be impossible until after repairs are properly effected.

Accordingly, pursuant to Florida Statute § 40.23(1), and this Court's inherent authority to administer and regulate the courts of the Twentieth Judicial Circuit pursuant to Fla. R. Jud. Admin. 2.050(b), it is

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that jurors may be summoned for circuit and county court proceedings in Glades County by the Clerk of the Court on less than fourteen (14) days' notice.

This order shall remain in effect until further order of the Court. The Court will periodically revisit the necessity of this order at least once each week and thereafter until the express provisions of Local Rule VII can be reinstated.
